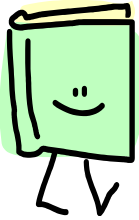

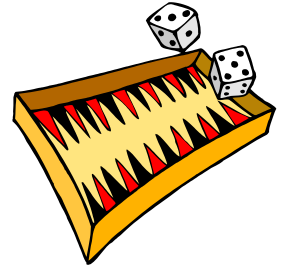

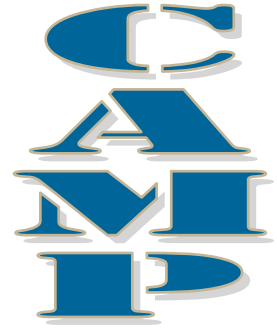

### THE SADDEST WORDS IN THE BIBLE?

Nehemiah was instrumental in rebuilding the walls of Jerusalem, and in beginning to restore the city to life and to its former glory. He was now going through the people of Israel and confronting them in a number of areas in their lives where they had neglected the ways of God. And in Nehemiah 13:23-24, he writes these words: “In those days I saw also Jews who had married women of Ashdod, Ammon and Moab. And half of their children spoke the language of Ashdod, and could not speak the language of Judah, but spoke according to the language of one or the other people.”

How tragic! The people of God had fallen so far from Him that their children had no understanding, at all, of the ways of God, of His standards, of His promises – their children never even knew the language of the people of God. I hope that strikes you as hard as it hits me, because that’s precisely the situation we find ourselves in today. Our children are well versed in the language of the streets, in the language of the hip (or hep or hoppin or radical or chillin or bad or rad or . . . or whatever the word is this year!), in the language of the thrasher, in the language of the gangsta, in the fashions of the day, in the music of the hour. But DO THEY KNOW THE LANGUAGE OF GOD?

What about your children? Will they grow up to know and follow the ways of our culture, or will they know and follow the ways of God? Your children need the church, desperately. You have a wonderful youth minister here, in Josh, and good youth sponsors. Do you thank them? Do you teach your children to respect and love them? Do YOU respect and love them? Do you make the church an important part of your life, so that your children will see your love for God, and your joy in gathering with His people?

Or do they see in you indifference? Do they see what a hassle it is to get up and go to church on Sunday morning, and what a drain on you it is to be involved in the ministries and service opportunities available here? Do they learn from you that Bible study isn’t important, or that prayer is just for the dinner table and bedtime, or that your small group isn’t important anyway – after all, you were there on Sunday and what more does that preacher want of us anyway?

Our children must have the grounding of fellowship with the people of faith, so that they will be able to stand when the winds of contemporary culture attempt to carry them along to the depths of hell. That’s what’s at stake here – no less than your child’s eternal destiny.

Our children need the church.

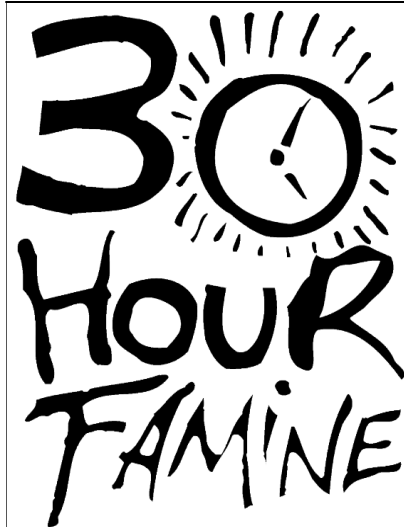
